Photography is an ideal companion to cycle touring, enabling us to recall places visited, companions, special events, etc. The aim of the Photographic sub-committee is to encourage West Kent members to enjoy their photography and share memories with others.

To this end, two competitions are arranged each year, catering for colour and black & white prints, plus digital images. The Summer Competition is a low-key affair, with entries being judged by members of the sub-committee, all entries later being displayed at the Clubroom on a winter's evening.

The Annual Competition, which has been held for over 60 years, is unique in the CTC circles. A qualified and experienced judge is invited to assess the entries, which are later displayed at the Annual Photographic Exhibition, open to the public, when certificates and trophies are awarded to the winners of the various classes.

This gives us some publicity as well as raising income for club funds. The evening usually incorporates an illustrated talk. The job of the sub-committee is to make all the necessary arrangements for these events and to man the hall on the day of the exhibition.
